Another "special" obliterator was in use in  $\mbox{M}$  O Y O G A L P A , a small dwelling not far from RIVAS.

It shows the form of a "DUPLEX" ( $\emptyset$  19 mm) with hollow (negative) letters **M O Y O.** The example shown here:




is so far the only one known and very rare. It is however possible that cancels of this kind from other little towns might exist and come to light one day!



### BUZON AMBULATE

Again another special cancel which also belongs to this period. It was used on the Railway - line CORINTO - LEON - MOMOTOMBO.

The BUZON AMBULANTE cancel from CORINTO has it's Duplex only 1mm to the right instead of 2mm on the normal cancels.

The BUZON AMBULANTE cancel from LEON looks more like the early special type cance of Corinto and has no Duplex, whereas the Corinto BUZON AMBULANTE cancel is more like the type of the II. Period. (Fig. 5 + 6)

The so far earliest known date of use is July 2, 1889. It seems that these cancels were in use during a short period only, i.e. between 1889 and 1893.

### CORREO URBANO

This cancel, intended for local mail, has also to be mentioned in this period. However, as it did not make much sense to use a special cancel CORREO URBANO just for local mail, it was also used for non-local mail, for instance as a transit postmark. (fig. 7)

Not very many covers or cards with this CORREO URBANO postmark have been saved to our times.














