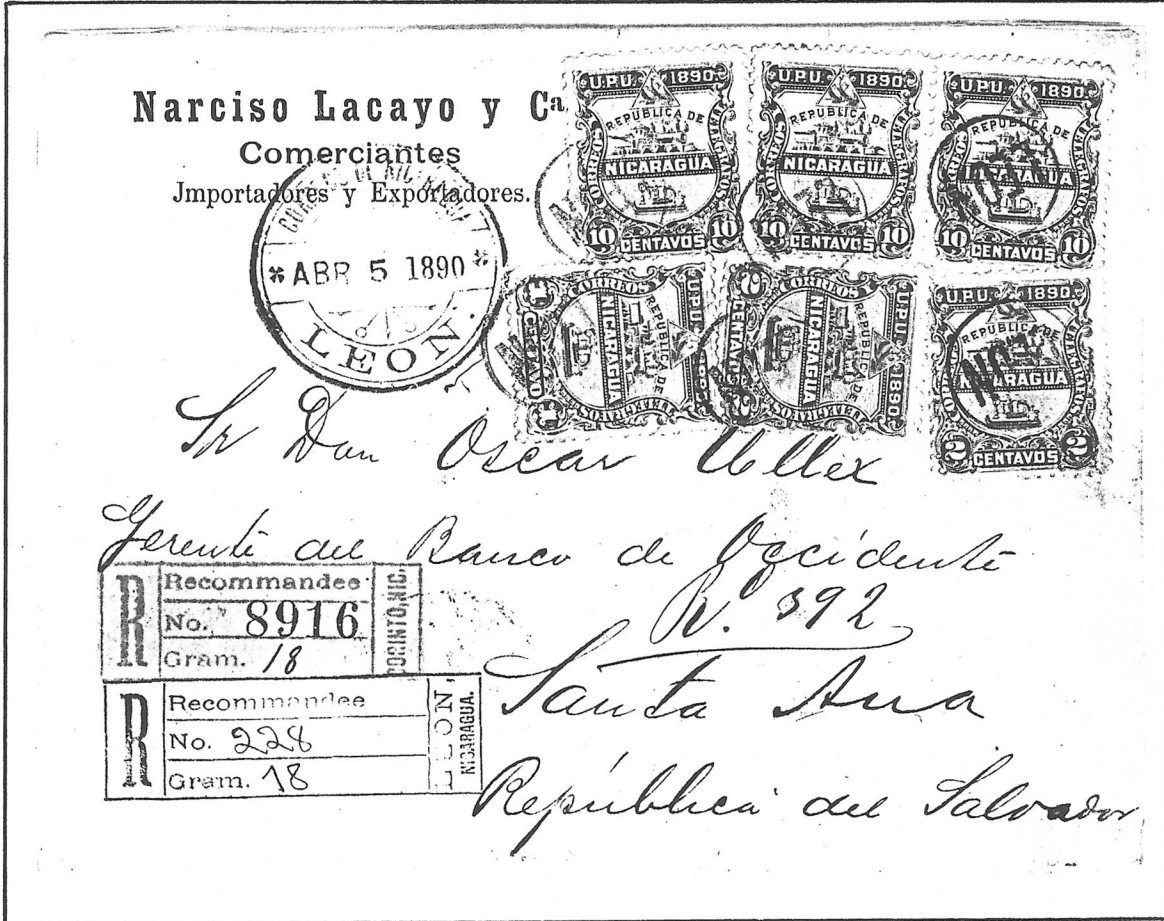

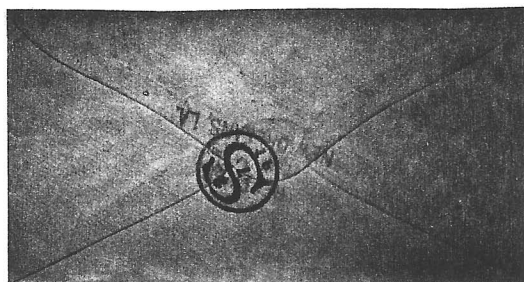

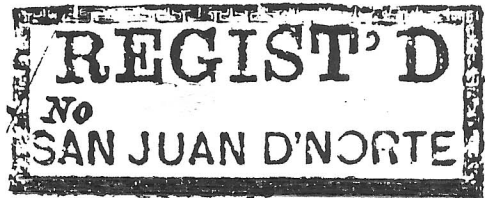

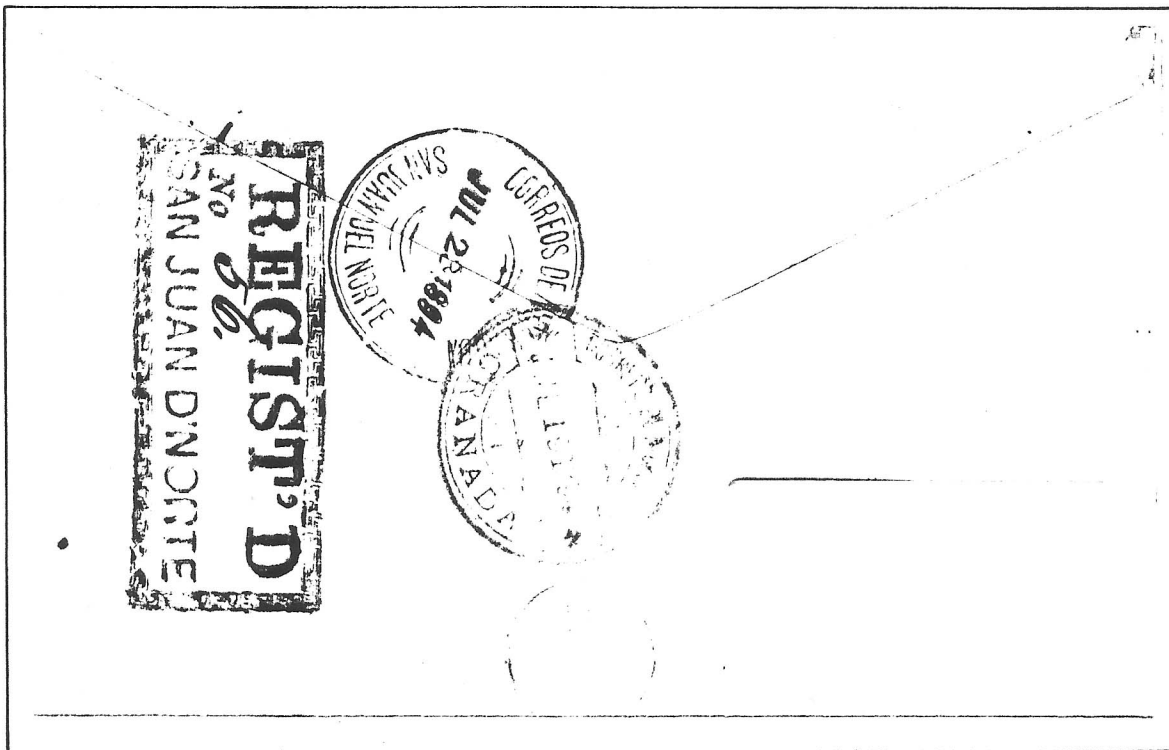

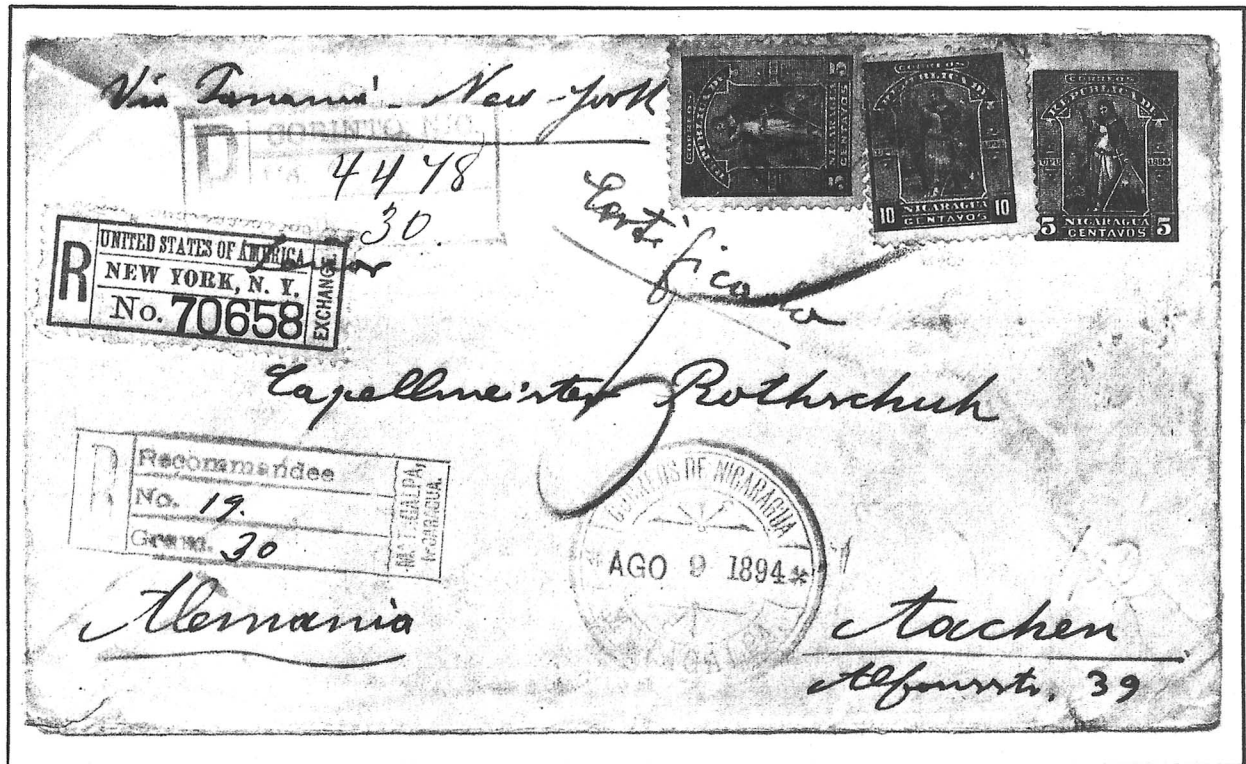

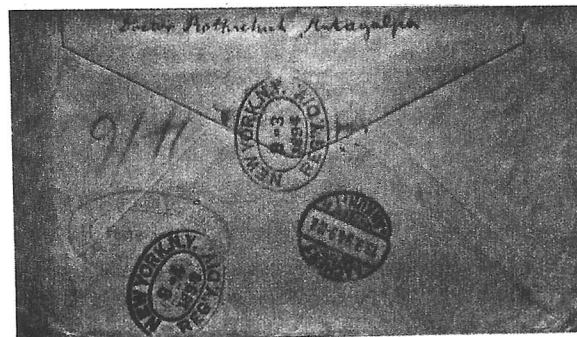

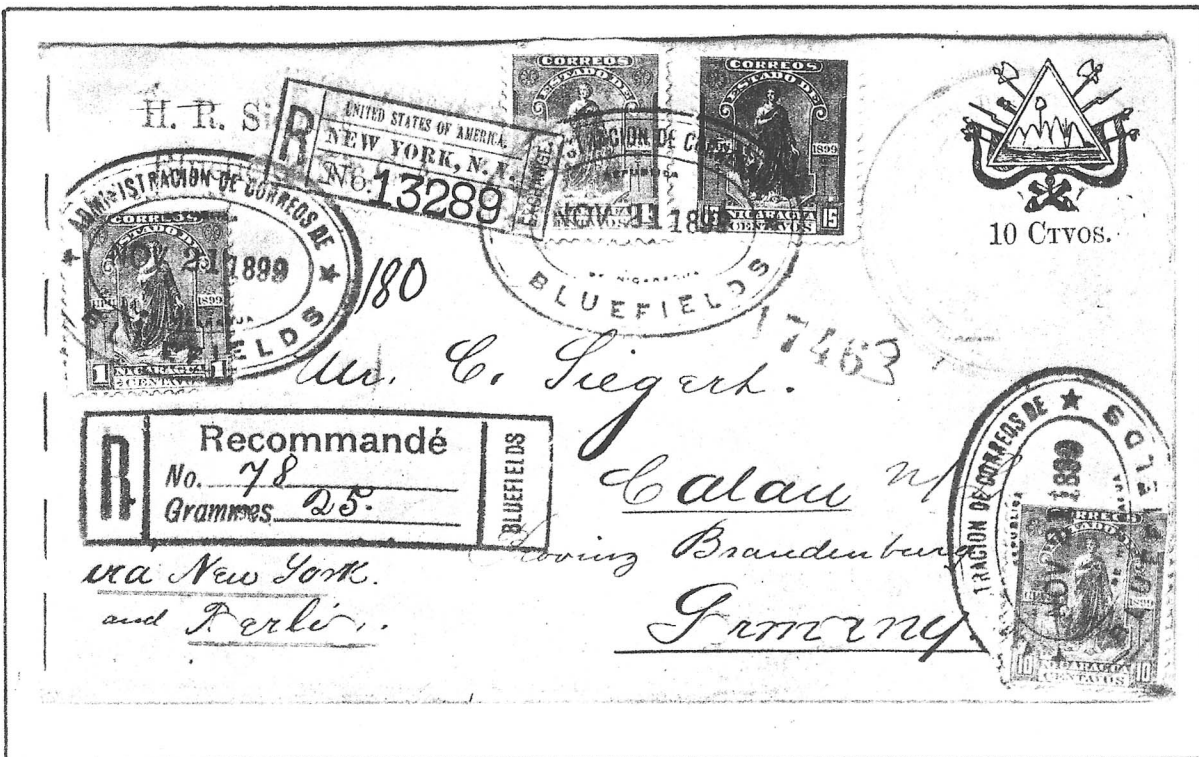

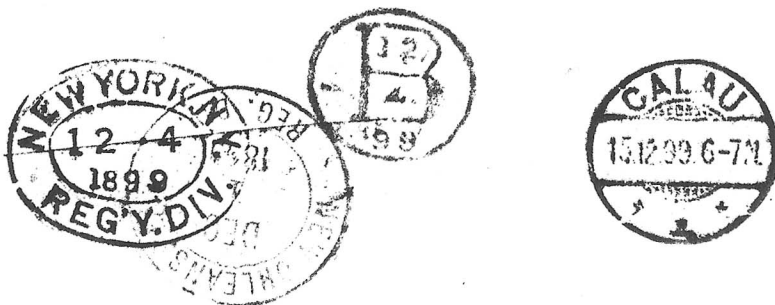
Tenth "Seebeck" issue, lithographed, 1899

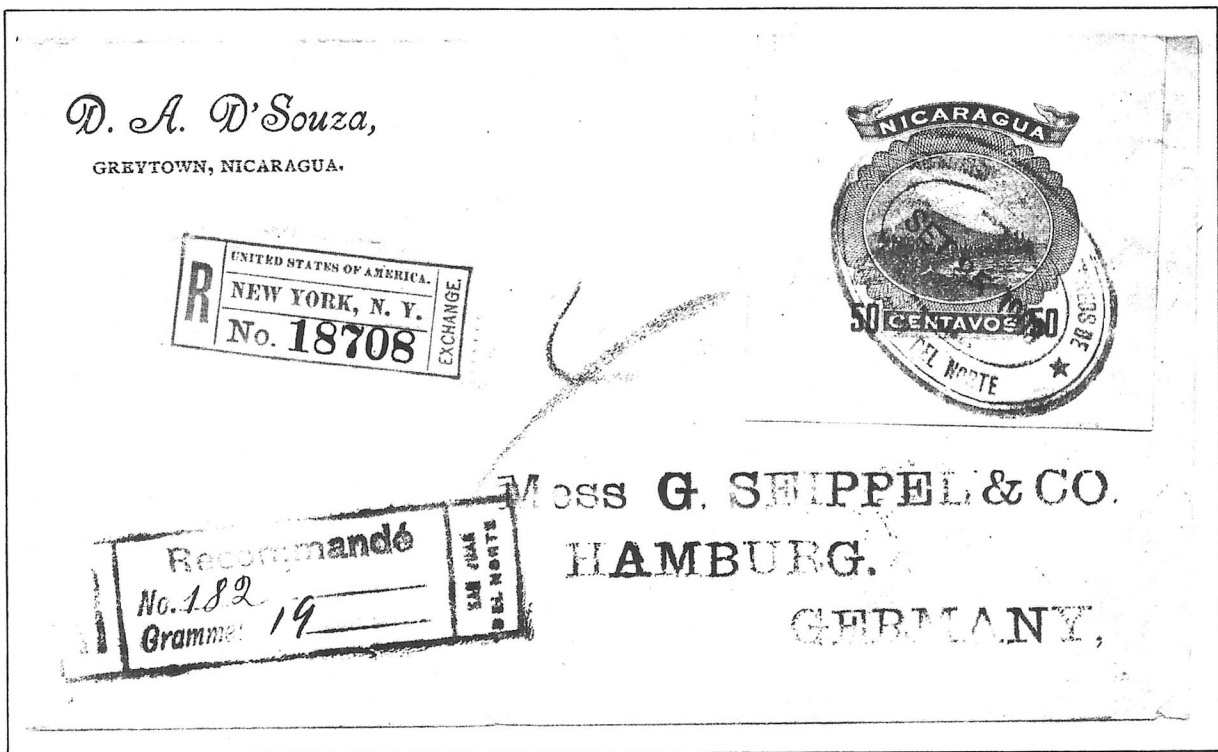

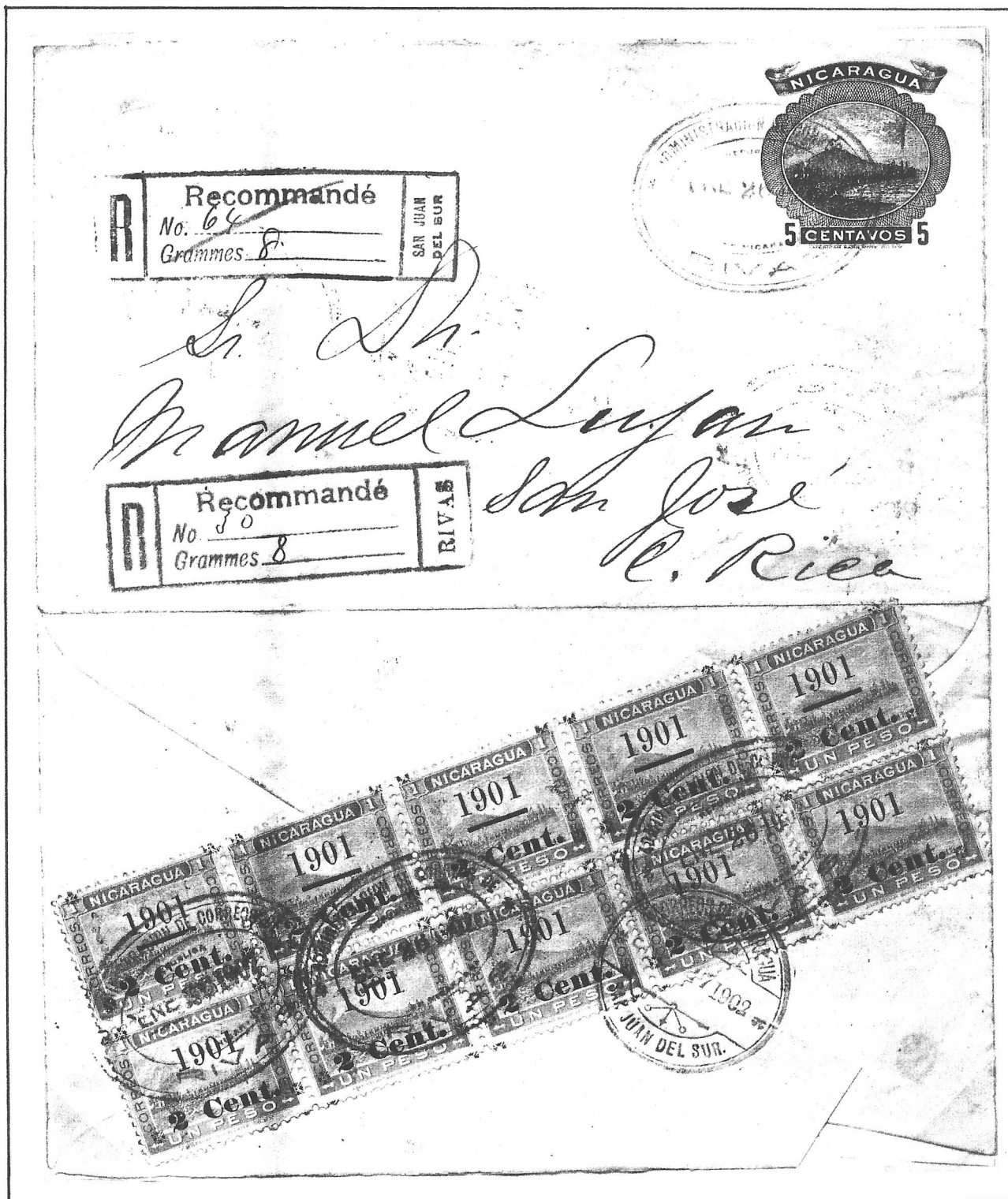

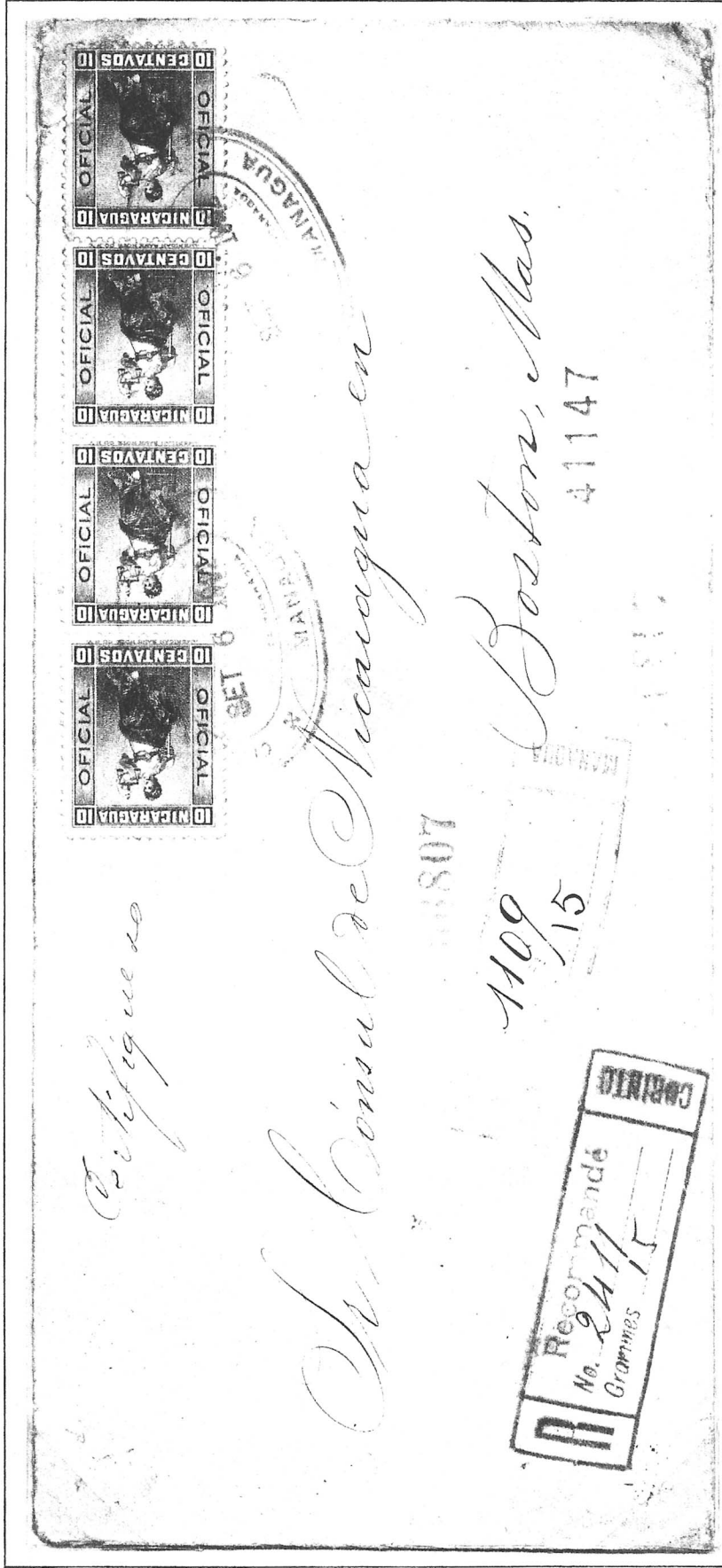
Cover from Rivas to San José, Costa Rica

How DOES HE KNOW?

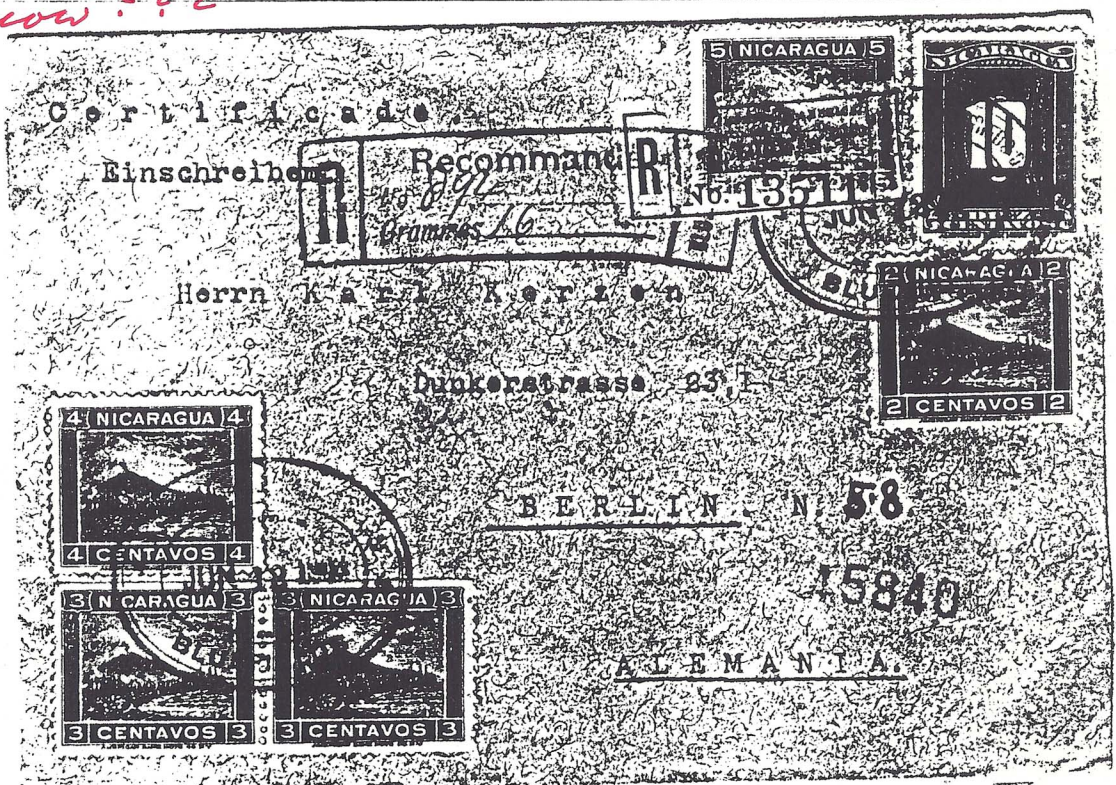
The 1900 Mount Momotombo issue overprinted in black. There was no official decree authorizing this issue. Very few of the 15 centavos was used. The 30 centavos is only known cancelled to order.

NOT TRUE
I have many stamps and about 10 covers!

 : This is NOT TRUE!
Have several stamps with GENUINE cancels!
The cancelled stamps of the 30 centavos overprint are rare and on covers EXTREMELY RARE, but exist. I have only 1 cover (see photostat) and have not yet seen another one!



How can this gentleman make such a statement, if he doesn't know ???

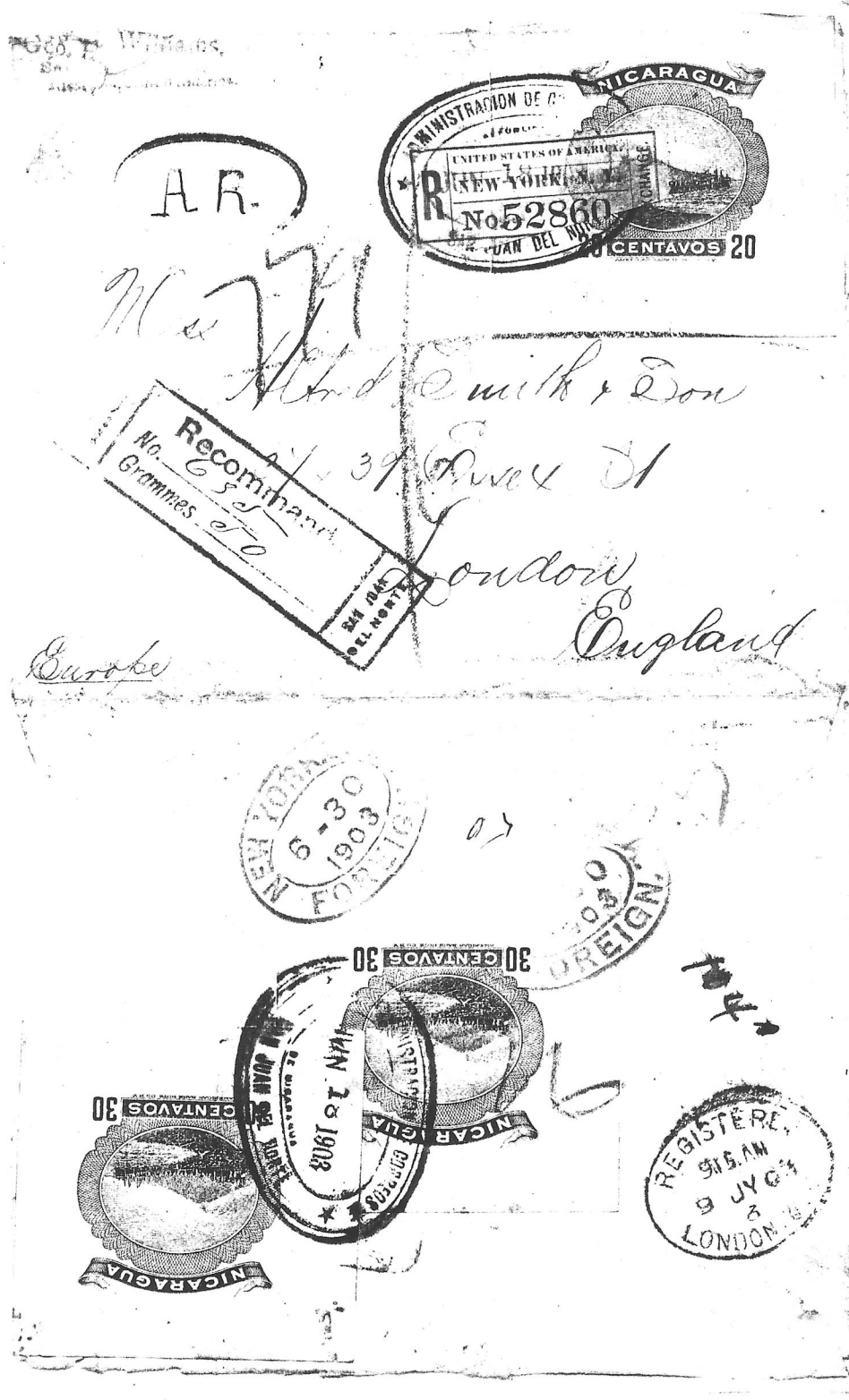

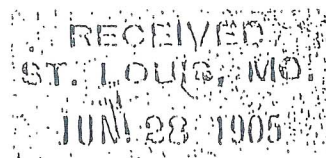

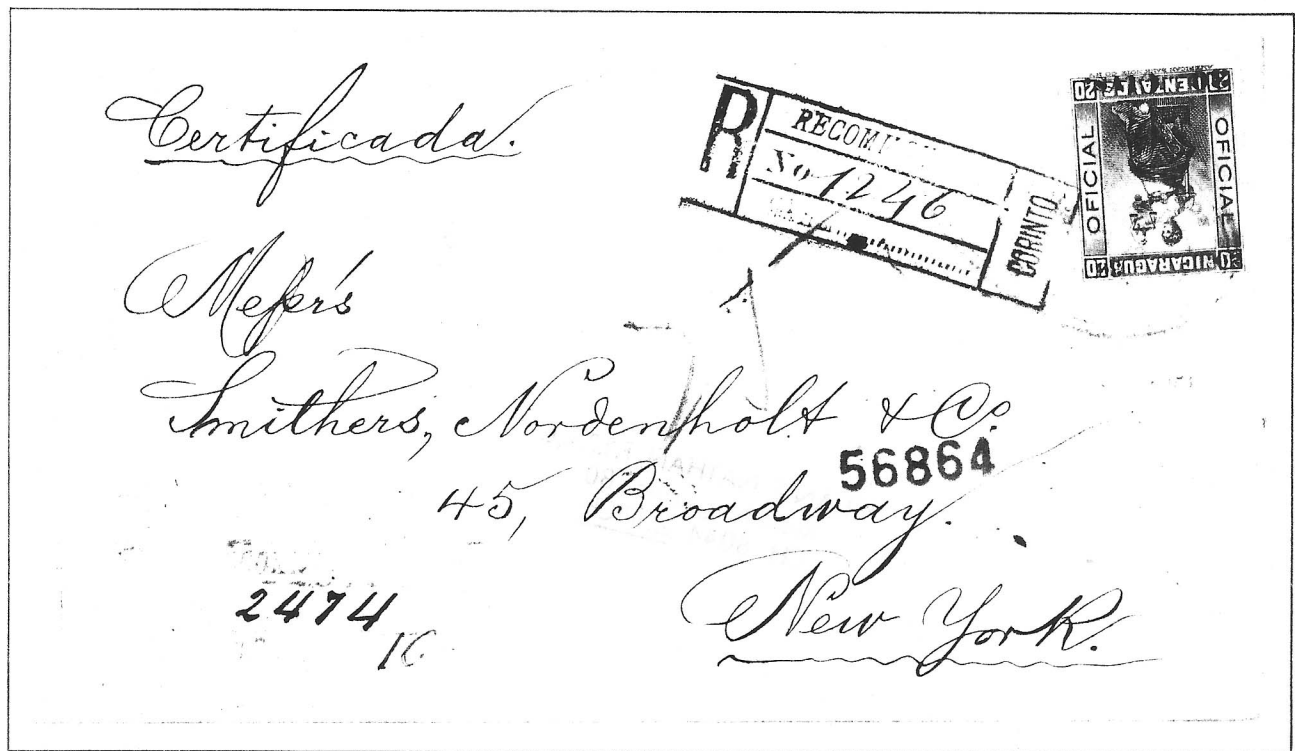

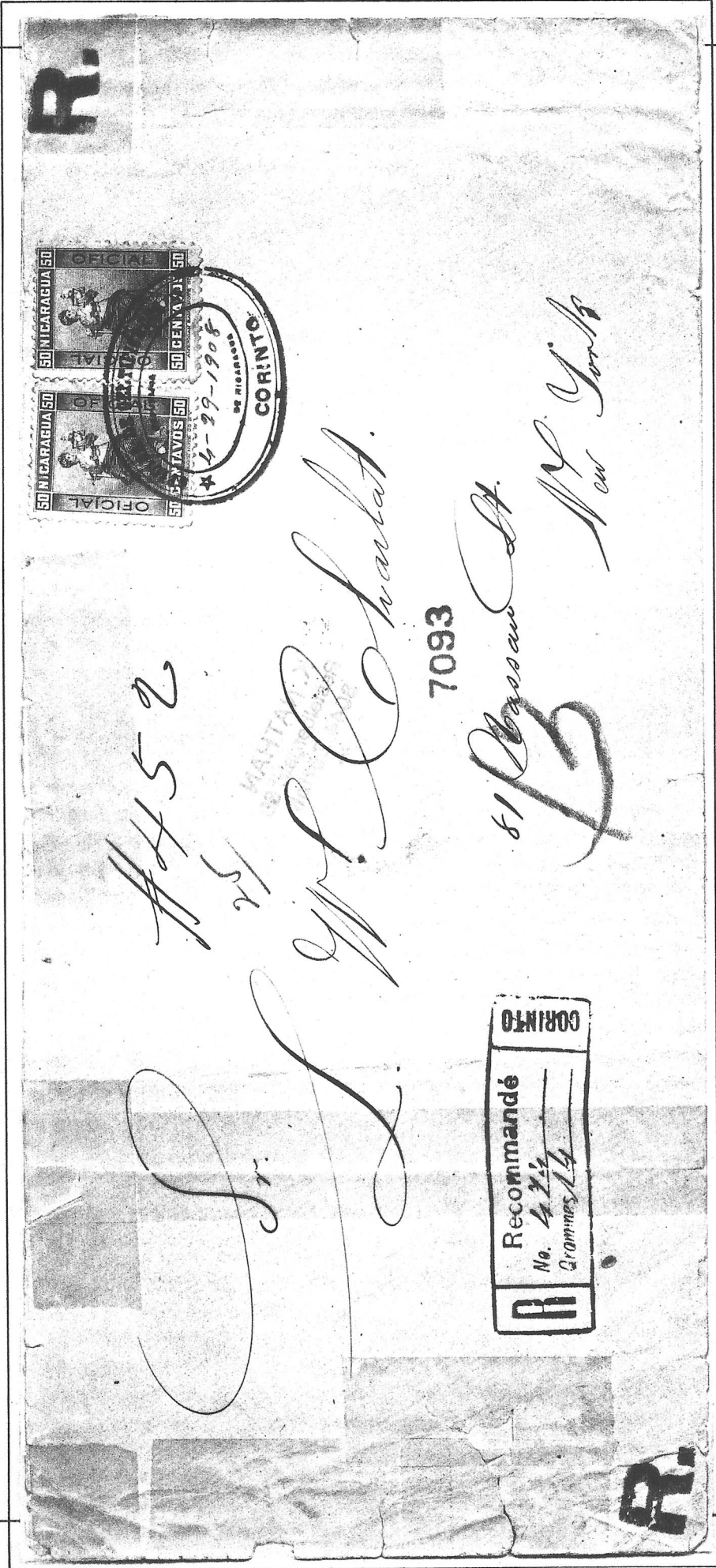
